ANIMAL CONTROL TRAP REQUEST

The following procedures are established and must be adhered to by citizens using city supplied animal traps to assure humane treatment to animals trapped in these cages.

Rules for Use- *Please initial beside each to indicate your understanding:*

1. Traps will only be handled, set, closed, opened or moved by an employee of the Police Department. You should never handle, move or touch the trap. _____
2. Traps are not set on weekends and holidays or during severe inclement weather and will be picked up on Fridays, no later than 7 p.m. We will not set traps if extreme weather or temperatures are expected (below 45 degrees or any location without protective shade). _____
3. Traps are only to be set in shaded areas and the final determination of where the trap will remain will be at the sole discretion of the Animal Control Officer. _____
4. Traps will be checked throughout the day, however please call Mebane Police at the 911 number to request that the trap be picked up if there is an animal inside. Animals may be under great stress within a trap and may cause neighbors to be disturbed from the noise. _____
5. I understand and grant the Mebane Police Department permission to enter my property at any reasonable time to monitor the trap as necessary. The Police Department reserves the right to refuse to set traps based on location, weather or other circumstances. _____
6. There are a limited number of traps available. If one is not available, you will be put on a waiting list and a trap will be set as it comes available. Traps are available to be placed in one location 5 days at a time before a new request must be made. _____

Failure to comply with any of the above will result in the trap being removed from your property.
