DO

- Put recycle out by 6am
- Secure loose newspaper or anything else that may blow away on high wind days
- Break down cardboard boxes
- Mark extra containers as Recycle
- If you put recycling in bags, use clear bags so the driver can see its recycling and not trash

DO NOT

- Assume the driver will come at the same time each day
- Have the bin where the driver can't see it

Recycling Glass Products

RECYCLE

- Glass bottles and jars
- Clear, brown, green and blue

PREPARE

- DISCARD CAPS and rinse containers clean
- Labels are OK

DO NOT INCLUDE

• Dishes, window glass, drinking glasses, mirror glass, cookware or light bulbs

Recycling Plastic Products

RECYCLE

- Plastic soda, liquor & drink bottles
- Milk, juice & water jugs
- Shampoo & Dish soap bottles

PREPARE

- DISCARD CAPS and rinse containers clean
- Smash flat
- Labels are OK

DO NOT INCLUDE

Plastic bags, toys, lids, antifreeze, motor oil or pesticide jugs

Recycling Paper Products

RECYCLE

Newspapers, inserts, phone books, magazines, cereal boxes, catalogs, & corrugated cardboard

PREPARE

• Bundle newspapers and magazines

DO NOT INCLUDE

- Paper towels, toilet paper
- waxed boxes
- pizza boxes soaked with grease

Recycling Metal Cans

RECYCLE

• Aluminum and steel/tin food and beverage cans

PREPARE

- Rinse clean
- Labels are OK

DO NOT INCLUDE

- Aluminum foil or trays
- Flammable liquid cans
- Paint cans
- Aerosol cans
- Put restricted items in bin
